### **Purpose of the job:**

The post holder will be expected to assist in a range of mechanical engineering tasks relating to the production of a variety of assistive living products within our workshops based in the Royal United Hospital and Victoria Business Park, Bath. They will also be expected to drive the company van to deliver or collect goods and materials locally, as well as monthly trips to take equipment to and from Outreach Centres (currently Leeds). The post will be based on 3 days / week with the potential for additional hours by mutual agreement.

### **Duties:**

1. Competent with a range of hand and basic machine tools
2. Ability to read and interpret assembly procedures/instructions
3. Manufacture of components using hand and machine tools
4. To assist with assembly of electromechanical products from subcomponents
5. Preparation of materials and sub-assemblies for finishing processes
6. To monitor stocks of components and packaging materials
7. Packaging of products prior to dispatch
8. Quality assurance of incoming and outgoing goods and materials
9. Driving company van, including deliveries to Outreach Centres

**The post holder will be expected to be able to show initiative and complete tasks without direct supervision.**
